From our sisters of REPAK we were informed that on last Sunday the premises of the Kurdish Woman's Relation Office (REPAK) in Erbil – Iraqi Kurdistan was raided by General Asayish Security Forces.

We the local Woman's group of Courage protest very strong that the office was raided and that the staff was deported. We convict this lawless and undemocratic attack against our sisters of REPAK.

This March we met members of REPAK at the World Woman's Conference in Kathmandu Nepal. We were very happy to hear from them about their struggle for woman's liberation in the southern part of Kurdistan, special also from Kobane.

With this protest note we demand, that the office of REPAK will be open again at once and all staff can come back to Erbil to continue their very necessary work.
